- Experimental drugs & new invasive tests
- Treatment for HIV using medical card
- Female related conditions not covered by policy but guised as another condition which is covered eg. Abortion
- Stroke in the 1st year of coverage

Life Cases

- Pre-existing Illness Role of underwriters.
- Purchase of life policy with intention.
- Intention to benefit from life policy even after recovery from illness.
- OKU Not conclusive of disability
- Technical difficulty in investigating on pre-existing conditions in life claims

Disadvantages

- PDPA 2010
- FSA 2013
- Medical Records Expunged after 6 years for private hospitals
- Consent by patient for medical records if patient refuses consent
- Time & Cost Willingness to investigate by insurer
